

Tonopah, July 18 - Glen Jean DeBeltrand prominent Silver Peak youth, passed away suddenly at his home in the Esmeralda camp Sunday following an attack of acute indigestion.

Stricken suddenly, DeBeltrand failed to respond to the use of a pulmotor and artificial respiration, and an autopsy performed in Tonopah revealed the ailment which caused his sudden death.

A native of Munsing, Mich, DeBeltrand was 30 years of age. He was a graduate of the Flint high school and later attended college in Detroit. He was employed as a police court stenographer in Michigan and worked as a stenographer in the federal archives bureau at Boulder City and Las Vegas after coming to Nevada in 1932.

Active in the Episcopal Church he had been a member of the church choir in Fling. He also took an interest in the Boy Scouts and was at one time scoutmaster in Las Vegas.

The family moved to Beatty two years ago and later went to Silver Peak, where the youth was employed in the office of the Mary mine at the time of his death.

Survivors include his mother Mrs. A Blinstrub; step-father Dr. A Blinstraub, and a brother, C. W. DeBelstrand. Funeral services will be held from the Wonacott & Cavanaugh chapel in Tonopah Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be made in the local cemetery.
