"Tonopah - Funeral services were held this afternoon from the Presbyterian Church here by the Rev. Hugh Huddleston, for Mrs. Margaret Mackintosh Coombs, mother of Mrs. Charles Mullen, who died in Tonopah, Tuesday.

Mrs. Coombs was a native of Prince Edward Island. Her father was a graduate of Edinburgh University and a member of the faculty of a boys college in the Canadian Province. She married Frank H. Coombs, a veteran of the Civil War in 1881.

The deceased was affiliated with the Gettysburg Post of the Women's Relief Corps, of the Grand Army of the Republic. During the World War she was conspicuous for her many talks on the American flag to the youths of Southern Nevada. She also at that time aided in welfare and hospitalization of boys called to the colors."
