

Mr. Cox was born in Grayville, IL, it is located in two counties and it is unknown which county he was born in. He lived for a brief time in Mexico, Canada and Seattle, WA before going to Goldfield in 1906. He moved to Manhattan in 1912 and finally to Tonopah in 1926 where he would make his home until his death. Although he had been an electrician for many years, since 1936 he had been in the hardware and furniture business.

"Mrs. Robert H. Thomas of Tonopah and her sister Mrs. Arthur Cox of Manhattan from several months visit to San Francisco."

Mr Cox was a 25 year member of both the Elks and Masons in Tonopah and the Kerek Shrine in Reno.

Arthur and his wife had one child Geraldine Cox. In Dec of 1936 she was a student at Anna Head School for girls on the coast (the coast being Berkeley, Alameda, CA). At the time of her father's death she was living in Memphis, TN her last name was Williams at the time. Geraldine had a son Robert Arthur Williams, also of Memphis at the time of his grandfather's death.
