18 Jan 1928 Reno Evening Gazette Funeral Held For Pioneer

"Tonopah - Funeral services for Dennis Coyle, pioneer resident of Nevada, who died here last week were held from the Catholic Church with interment in the local cemetery.

Mr. Coyle was born in Ireland in 1850 (date is as stated in the newspaper) and went to Eureka when he was twenty-five years old. He was seventy-seven at the time of his death. In 1878 he was married in Eureka to Margaret Cassidy and four children were born to the union of whom three survive, Mrs. James Hill of Tonopah, with whom Mr. Coyle made his home; Ed Coyle of Hamilton and Mrs. Owen Dougherty of Oakland (Alameda, CA)."

His parents were both born in Ireland, it is unknown if they came to the United States or remained in Ireland.

He and Margaret are enumerated in the 1920 Illipah, White Pine census.
