

Resident of Tonopah since 1909, he died at the Nye County Hospital. Mr. Daniels was a graduate of Michigan College of Law but he did not practice law in Tonopah until after serving as deputy clerk in the office of the late Robert Pohl. In 1931 he was elected District Attorney of Nye County and was never defeated for that office. He joined the Tonopah Lodge B.P.O.Elks in 1931, the same year as his arrival in Tonopah. He served as secretary for that lodge from 1911 to 1946 when his health issues forced him to resign. He also served our country in WWI and was secretary of the American Legion post in Tonopah. At the time of his death he had been a patient at the Nye County Hospital since 1946 when he suffered a paralytic stroke, from which he never recovered.
