"Tonopah - Dec 24 - Martin L. Filippini, veteran Nye county stockman, passed away at the Mine Operators Hospital (Tonopah) following a paralytic stroke. In failing health for several years, Filippini was stricken four days ago at the Jim Butler Ranch where he had been employed. He was brought to the hospital immediately but failed to rally and passed away Friday afternoon (23 Dec 1938).

He is survived by four sisters, Mrs. W. A. Porch of Montana, Mrs. Camille Cassela of Roscoe, Cal., Mrs. Lena Tacino of Steamboat, Nev., and Mrs. Darling of Reno; one son Melvin Filippini of Tonopah.
