Carolyn Klapper Funeral Held

"Tonopah - Funeral services for Carolyn Mae Klapper, 14 year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Klapper of Tonopah who died suddenly on July 19, were conducted from St. Mark's Episcopal Church Saturday morning at 10:00. Nurial was in the Tonopah Cemetery.

Born at Hamilton, Ohio, March 5 (notation is correct although it differs from the headstone which states she was born on the 6th) 1936, Carolyn Mae Klapper moved to Tonopah with her parents when she was two years old and had lived here since that time. She attended the Tonopah grade school and was graduated from the eighth grade last June. She planned to enter a convent school in California this fall to begin her High School education.

Surviving are her father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. James Klapper, a younger brother and sister Jimmy and Johana, two uncles, Ralph Cox of Colorado and Robert Cox of Woodland, Calif., and other relatives in Ohio."
