Accident Victim's Funeral Held In Tonopah

"Tonopah - Funeral services were held here for Domenick Mane, Manhattan mine employee and resident of this section for a number of years, who died at the local mines hospital as a result of a mine accident at the Cole-Kirchen placer property.

Services conducted from the Wonnacott and Cavanaugh mortuary with Father William Devlin officiating and interment was in the Tonopah Cemetery.

Caught and dragged into the drum of a hoist, Mane's left arm was torn from his body, the tear extended into the lung. He lived but a few hours after being taken to the local hospital."
