Services Held For Mrs. Marsh

"Tonopah - Hundreds of persons paid their respects to a pioneer of Tonopah Wednesday afternoon (13 Mar 1940) as impressive funeral services were held from the Tonopah Elks home for Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Marsh, widow of the late William A. Marsh, Nye County State Senator. Mrs. Marsh died at her home here late Monday afternoon (11 Mar 1940) from a heart attack.

Cecil Bunker delivered an impressive eulogy as the last rites were held for the popular matron, while Mrs. Mary Ross rendered two vocal numbers during the services. An abundance of floral pieces were banked around the casket.

Pallbearers, all friends of the Marsh family for a long period of time, included Leland Henderson, Belmont Douglass, George Barra, Clyde Pettygrove, Dutch Helmicj and Harry Brotherton. A long cortege of cars accompanied the body to the Tonopah Cemetery where burial was made in the Elks plot beside the grave of the late Senator Marsh, who died two years ago."
