10 Jan 1925 Reno Evening Gazette Belmont Pioneer Is Dead At 87

"Tonopah, Jan 10 - Mrs. Grace Elizabeth McCann, eighty-seven years of age, died Wednesday morning at the home of her daughter Mrs. George (Mary Anna McCann Sharp), at Blue Eagle in the extreme southeastern end of the county. Death was due to congestion of the lungs. The body was brought here Thursday morning.

Mrs. McCann was born in Dungiven, Ireland and came to this country when nineteen years of age, making her home with relatives in Boston. After three years she went to California where she married Bernard McCann. A few years later the couple moved to Austin (NV) and after a short residence they cast their lot with Belmont, then the leading mining center of the state.
