John Millen Funeral Held

"Tonopah, Jan 10 - Funeral services for John C. Millen, 79, who died at his home here on December 29, were held from the Masonic Temple on Saturday afternoon, January 3. Officers of Tonopah Lodge No 28 F. & A. M., under the direction of Worshipful Master Fred B. Ritter conducted the last rites and three hymns were played by Mrs. A.R. Wardle.

Burial took place in the Masonic Plot of the Tonopah Cemetery and casket bearers were Lee Henderson, A.R. Wardle, T.E. Boyd, Jack Buckhouse, Howard O'Bryant and O.D. Welsch.

Mr. Millen was born in Norway on August 5, 1872. He came to the United States when he was 16 years old and later became a naturalized citizen. As a young man he went to Alaska, where he lived for many years., and then moved to Yerington. He also lived at Goldfield and in 1926 moved to Tonopah. He followed mining for many years. Mr. Millen joined the Masonic order during his residence at Yerington and later transferred his membership to the local lodge.
