Miller Burial Service Held

"Tonopah - Funeral rites were held here Tuesday for Lou Miller, whose death occurred at a local hospital Saturday. Interment was in the Tonopah Cemetery.

Deceased had been an active resident of Nevada for thirty five years. Born in Illinois sixty-seven years ago, Mr. Miller followed the lure of mining in the west. In the boom days of Goldfield and Tonopah he owned and operated a fleet of six freight wagons which hauled supplies to Goldfield and Tonopah from the railroad terminal at Sodaville. After the railroad came into the two camps, he turned his business efforts to mining and at the time of his death was connected with several mining operations in this vicinity. He never married and leaves no relatives here."
