Neilson Burial Held

"Tonopah - Hundreds of friends gathered Sunday afternoon at funeral services held here for Mrs. Irene Neilson, wife of Arbin Neilson of this city. The rites took place at the Presbyterian Church, the Reverend A. G. Shriver of Carson City officiating. The church service and eulogy read by Mr. Shriver were accompanied by a song by members of the church choir with Miss Addie DePew at the organ. A wealth of floral tributes banked the casket and altar. Intimate friends acting as casket bearers were Emery Marty, Allen Rives, C.W. Pribbernow, Cecil Brown, Frank Henderson and John Traynor. Interment was made in the family plot of the Tonopah Cemetery, beside the grave of Mr. and Mrs. Neilson's eleven year old son and only child, Eugene Edward, whose death preceded that of his mother by a few days. Following the death of her son here on December 30, the result of pneumonia, Mrs. Neilson was stricken with the same illness and succumbed Friday evening.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Martin of this city, Mrs. Neilson was a member of one of Tonopah's earlier families and since her girlhood had been active here in community affairs. She leaves besides her husband and her parents, four brothers, William and Byron Martin of Tonopah, Harold and Russell Martin of Arizona."
