Oliver Perry Buried At Tonopah Today

"Tonopah, Jan 4 - The funeral of the late Oliver H. Perry was held this afternoon from his former residence on Boker Street with Rev. Frank W. Manderson officiating. Mr. Perry died suddenly Monday morning shortly after starting the fires in his home. He appeared in the best of health and his cheerfulness was remarked upon. Suddenly he paused and dropped on a couch where he expired. Deceased is survived by a widow and one daughter, Miss Hazel, secretary of John G. Kirchen, of the Tonopah Extension Mining Company. Mr. Perry was sixty-one years of age and had been a resident of Tonopah for eighteen years."
