Louis Pressinger Dies At Tonopah

"Tonopah, May 15 - Louis Pressinger, resident of Tonopah since 1909, died suddenly at his home Wednesday noon. He collapsed while entering his home after a walk downtown and died before medical attention could be administered. Death was attributed to a heart ailment.

A native of Germany, Pressinger would have observed his eighty-first birthday on May 31, as he was born in 1863. He came to the United States when a young man and was naturalized in 1884. Prior to moving to Tonopah he had resided in the east and middle west and had followed his trade as a carpenter until he retired a few years ago.

His wife died several years ago and his only known survivor is a brother, Anton Pressinger, who lives at Appleton, Wisc.

Funeral services were conducted from the Catholic Church Saturday morning and interment took place in the family plot in the Tonopah Cemetery."
