Rites conducted for Emma Ramos

"Tonopah, Oct 5 - A native of Nye County and a resident of this vicinity all her life, Mrs. Emma Ramos, thirty, died Tuesday (28 Sep 1943) following a lingering illness. Funeral services, under the direction of the Rev. Francis Mikula of St Patrick's Church were conducted Friday morning (1 Oct 1943) from the Wonacott and Cavanaugh Chapel. Burial took place in the local cemetery.

Mrs. Ramos' husband, Fidel Ramos, Tonopah miner died only a few months ago, and her passing left five young children orphans. The children, Irene, Paul, Joe, Junior (Fidel I would assume), and Daniel are to be taken to Stewart Indian School to complete their education. In addition to her children, Mrs. Ramos is survived by her mother, Mrs. Mattie Thomas."
