Sheriff's Wife Dies At Tonopah

"Tonopah, July 1 - Mrs. Tillie B. Thomas, wife of Sheriff W.H. Thomas of Nye County, died Wednesday night following an illness of eighteen months.

She was born in Austin fifty-eight years ago and spent her entire life in Nevada. She moved to Tonopah in 1901, in the first days of the Tonopah boom. She had been active in the community affairs and was widely known for her many charitable works.

Surviving besides her husband are a brother, John Dias of Battle Mountain, and other relatives. Funeral services will be held from the family home in Tonopah Saturday with burial in the local cemetery."
